### **Project Friday**

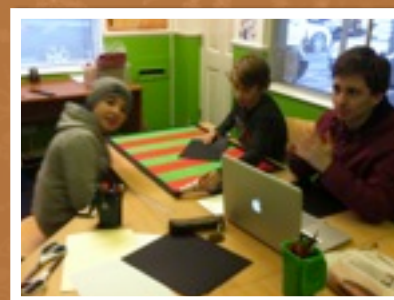

### **Food Week**

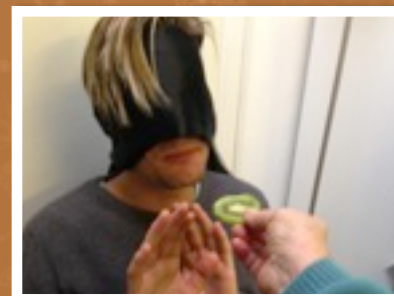
